						1975	On January 1, 1975, the Taiwanese government promulgated the key points for the implementation of the Agricultural Water Conservancy Association during the period of accelerated rural development in Taiwan. During the implementation period, elections of member representatives would be temporarily suspended, while the chairman would be appointed by the government.	
						1981	On December 31, 1981, the improvement period of the Farmland Water Conservancy Association was completed and the original organization was restored. Election of member representatives and president resumed.	
						1993	On February 3, 1993, the General Rules of the Farmland Water Conservancy Association was amended, and the member representatives were changed to committee members. Both the chairman and committee members were to be appointed by competent authority. On June 1, 1994, the first term of chairman and committee members were appointed.	
						2001	On June 20, 2001, the general organization rules of the Farmland Water Conservancy Association were revised again, chairman and committee members were elected by members through direct election; on June 1, 2002, the first directly elected term of chairman and committee members was elected.	
						2006	In June 2006, the first directly elected term of chairman and committee members was elected.	
						2010	In June 2010, the 3rd directly elected term of chairman and committee members was elected.
